Minutes of the 19th Annual General Meeting of Leathergoods And Footwear Manufacturers & Exporters Association of Bangladesh (LFMEAB) held on Sunday, 8th January, 2023.

The 19th Annual General Meeting of Leathergoods And Footwear Manufacturers & Exporters Association of Bangladesh (LFMEAB) was held on Sunday 8th January 2023 at 7:00 pm at Hotel Lake Shore, House No-46, Road-41, Gulshan-2, Dhaka-1212. Mr. Syed Nasim Manzur, President of LFMEAB presided over the AGM session.

After the quorum of the meeting, the Secretary General called the meeting to order. With the permission from the Chair, Secretary General of LFMEAB Major Md Rafiqul Islam (Retd) read out the Notice of 19^h Annual General Meeting for the year July 2021-June 2022, which was circulated earlier. Afterward, President welcomed all the members present at the AGM and proceeded with the meeting according to the following agenda:

- 1. To confirm the minutes of the 18th Annual General Meeting held on 12th March 2022 at 12 pm.
- 2. Presentation of the Annual Report 2021-2022 of the Association and adoption thereof.
- 3. Presentation of the audited accounts of the Association for the year July 2021-June 2022 and auditor's report thereon.
- 4. To appoint auditor for the July 2022-June 2023 and determine their remuneration.
- 5. Announcement of the result of LFMEAB Election 2023-2025 and introduction of new Executive Committee for the year 2023-2025 by the Chairperson, Election Board.

Agenda-1: to confirm the minutes of the 18th Annual General Meeting.

The minutes of the 18th Annual General Meeting held on Saturday, 12th March 2022 at 12 PM at MCCI-BEF's office at Police Plaza Concord, circulated among the General Body members earlier and placed before the AGM for approval. President invited comments from members on the tabled minutes. The President of LFMEAB proposed that if there was no objection, the minutes might be treated as read and confirmed. Having received no revisions or observations from anyone, on a proposal from Mr. M. Amirullah, Managing Director, H.N. Shoes Ltd. and seconded by Mr. Rupak Bhowmick, Deputy Country Manager, Nadia Shoes Pvt Ltd., the meeting confirmed the minutes.

Agenda-2: Presentation of the Annual Report 2021-2022 of the Association and adoption thereof

In the presentation of the Annual Report 2021-2022, President highlighted the state of the economy at home and abroad as well as industry export performance; major initiatives taken by the association in 2021-2022 and finally presented a summary of the financial statement.

Mr. President presented the Annual Report for the fiscal year July 2021-June 2022 where he reported that the export earnings from the country's leather sector, the second-largest earner of foreign currency witnessed a 32% growth in the fiscal year July 2021-June 2022. It exported nearly 1700 USDM from leather & leather products and footwear. Mr. President emphasized value growth and value chain market development. He said that there is a high growth possibility for

Bangladesh's leather products and leather and synthetic footwear export industry as there are relocating opportunities for Bangladesh to grab.

In his speech, Mr. President told that during the fiscal year July 2021-June 2022, despite different challenges, particularly in the context of the post-Covid slow recovery, the war in Ukraine, and the sluggish economic activities in major export markets; the industry has shown its resilience. Overall, the leather, leather products, and footwear sector, as a whole, showed over 30% growth and closer to 2 billion (1700 USDM) export. Thus, Bangladesh's leather products and footwear export has come a long way and will continue to grow further.

Mr. President also welcomed newly joined 13 members of LFMEAB.

After discussion, on the proposal from Mr. Sadat Hossain Salim, Chairman, Craftsman Footwear and Accessories Limited and seconded by Mr. Jahangir Alam Khan, Managing Director, Italy Footwear Limited the meeting confirmed the presentation of the Annual Report 2021-2022.

Agenda-3: Presentation of the audited accounts of the Association for the year July 2021-June 2022 and auditor's report thereon

Mr. President presented the audited accounts of the Association for the year July 01, 2021 to June 30, 2022. There was item-wise discussion on the balance sheet, income-expenditure statement and etc. President asked if there was any comment that needs explanation. Members present expressed satisfaction with the financial position of the Association. President then requested for acceptance and adoption of the Annual Audited Accounts. The Audit Report of LFMEAB for the fiscal year July 2021-June 2022 was approved unanimously at the AGM on a proposal from Mr. Sadat Hossain Salim, Chairman, Craftsman Footwear And Accessories Limited. which was seconded by Mr. Md. Rakib Uddin Dewan (Ratan), Chairman, Golden Sky Footwear Limited.

Agenda-4: To appoint auditor for July 2022-June 2023 and determine their remuneration.

Mr. President informed the house that Ashraful Haque Nabi & Co., Chartered Accountants audit firm rendered audit services for the period from 2019-June 2020 to July 2021-June 2022. However, for better transparency, it has been decided to appoint a new audit firm.

LFMEAB asked for quotations and received Express of Interest (EoI) from three firms; Khan Ayub, Ashraful Haque Nabi & Co. and ACNABIN Chartered Accountants to undertake the audit. Considering its credibility and reputation ACNABIN Chartered Accountants was selected to appoint with remuneration tk. 50,000/- (including VAT & TAX).

The meeting confirmed the appointment of ACNABIN for July 2022- June 2023 and adopted on a proposal from Mr. Labik Kamal, Director of Operations, ECM Footwear Ltd. and seconded by Mr. Rupak Bhowmick, Deputy Country Manager, Nadia Shoes Pvt Ltd.

Agenda-5: Announcement of the result of LFMEAB Election 2023-2025 and introduction of new Executive Committee for the year 2023-2025 by the Chairperson, Election Board.

Annual Report

(FY July 2022- June 2023)

Distinguished members of the General Body and my dear colleagues in the Board of Directors of LFMEAB, ladies, and gentlemen,

Assalamu Alaikum and good evening.

It is a great pleasure and opportunity for me to welcome you all to the 20th Annual General Meeting of the fiscal year July 2022-June 2023 of Leathergoods And Footwear Manufacturers & Exporters Association of Bangladesh (LFMEAB).

In the present context, I would like to apprise you of the following issues –

- a) Current global economic outlook
- b) National economic situation
- c) Sectoral export performance
- d) Major activities of the association round the year, and
- e) Financial summary

Current Global Economic Outlook

UNCTAD's Trade and Development Report 2023 reported that world economic growth slowed from 3% in 2022 to 2.4% in 2023 with few signs of a rebound in the current year. Global growth is forecast to moderately pick up to 2.7 percent in 2024. According to IMF, world economic growth slowed from 3.5 percent in 2022 to 3 percent in 2023 and projected 2.9% in 2024.

According to the Market Intelligence report, demand for goods remained under pressure from past interest rate hikes. Forward-looking indicators have also hinted at more conservative expectations concerning manufacturing production. By broad product category, the intermediate goods sector was again the worst performer. Consumer goods notably recorded the slowest decline in new export orders since March 2023.

Trade deteriorated across all the top 10 economies except India. Among the developed markets tracked, the EU remained the worst performer at the end of 2023, as its trade downturn extended to 22 months. The UK and Japan meanwhile saw comparatively mild declines in goods trade. Japan saw increased rates of decline in exports but in the UK a faster fall in manufacturing exports. This bleak economic situation is creating slow market demands and sluggish manufacturing and export business at home and abroad.


National Economic Situation

Although Bangladesh's economy has recovered from the economic damage caused by the impact of COVID-19 and the ongoing Russia-Ukraine crisis, the recent slowdown in the global economy has adversely affected the country's economic growth. In FY 2022-23, as per the Bangladesh Bureau of Statistics (BBS), GDP grew by 6.03 percent against the target of 7.5 percent. However, according to the World Bank, Bangladesh's GDP grew by less than 6% in FY 2022-23. Slow GDP growth was due to elevated inflation, slowing exports and remittances, and the ongoing pressure on the country's foreign exchange reserves.

According to the Export Promotion Bureau (EPB), Bangladesh earned \$55.55 billion in export earnings in fiscal year 2022-23, seeing a narrow growth of 6.67% year-on-year. However, Bangladesh earned 4.28% less than the export target, which was set at \$58 billion, due to the slow demand, ongoing economic turmoil, geopolitical crisis, and inflationary pressures in key destinations. Consequently, exporters are going through a tight business situation due to the pressure from disruptions of logistic networks and increases in shipping costs, inadequate energy supply, high inflation increases in commodity prices, and prices of raw materials among others.

Sector Export Performance

Export earnings from the country's leather, leather products, and footwear sector; the second-largest earner of foreign currency after the ready-made garments (RMG) industry, witnessed 0.48% growth in the FY2022-23.



During the period, we:

- Exported 1702.48 USDM from leather & leather products (41-43 & 6403) and non-leather footwear (64) (Excluding 6403).
- Exported 1223.62 million USD from leather & leather products (41-43 & 6403).
- Non-leather footwear recorded more than7% growth over SPLY indicating the upward

trend of export of non-leather footwear. Bangladesh earned 123.44 USD million from leather (Chapter 41) with 18% down, 396.67 USD million from leather products (42-43) with 17% export growth, and 703.81 USD million from leather footwear (6403) with 7% down over FY 2021-22.

Total export of leather & leather products (41-43 & 6403) and other footwear (64) (excluding 6403) reached 1702.48 USDM in FY 2022-23, whereas it was 1694.33 USDM in FY 2021-22. Overall, export performance in the reported period shows that the Bangladesh leather export industry along with its all subsectors surpassed the export performance of the previous financial year with a slightly upward trend.

Key Activities of LFMEAB

LFMEAB works in the areas of providing regular services to members timely and efficiently, export promotion, policy support, communication, and coordination with concerned Ministries, national and international organizations, development partners, and related stakeholders. The FY 2022-2023 was eventful and important to us, primarily because of the significant recovery from Covid 19 pandemic. After the last AGM of LFMEAB, we worked with many vital issues. The following are the most notable events of the financial year:

- LFMEAB -
- Issued over twenty thousand different basic services such as GSP recommendations, TT certificates, and bond license recommendations among others.
- Conducted 212 compliance audits in 125 different factories.
- 3) We have formed 7 Standing Committees in LFMEAB to identify concerned sectoral problems and formulate recommendations for solutions.
- Arranged different call-on meetings with the Prime Minister's Office, Ministry of Finance, Ministry of Commerce, NBR, and Customs Bond Commissionerate (CBC) among others.
- 5) Hosted General Meeting and Night for LFMEAB members on 21 August, 2022.
- 6) Organized a workshop on "Bonded Warehouse and Customs Management in Leather goods and Footwear Industry- Opportunities and Challenges" on 29 November, 2022.
- Participated in many seminars, round-tables, dialogues, and consultations on different trade, export, and policy-related issues to highlight

- the leather products and footwear sector's challenges and presented our evidence-based points of view.
- 8) Ensured 100% Group Insurance coverage for eligible factories.
- 9) Ascertained total 19 coefficients with 221 styles of footwear and leather goods.
- 10) Assessed the 35-member factories regarding gaps analysis in electrical installation and practice systems and provided individual remediation.
- Arranged findings sharing workshop on electrical assessment in leather goods and footwear industry.
- 12) A factory improvement program has been launched to develop social and environmental compliance among around 100-member factories.
- 13) More than 25 factories were trained on capacity building of the Participatory Committee, Safety Committee, and Anti-Harassment Committee under the Social Dialogue Program-STILE initiative.
- 14) Organized one week of Pattern Engineering of Footwear Manufacturing training by an international trainer from Footwear Design and Development Institute (FDDI), India.
- 15) Participated in Best of Bangladesh Expo 2023 on the Occasion of the 50th Anniversary of FBCCI, and LFMEAB stall obtained bronze prize in "Best Innovative Stall" in the Best of Bangladesh Expo 2023.
- 16) KRC continued to provide sector-related data, research-backed policy briefs, position papers, and maintain collaboration with global industry stakeholders among others.
- 17) Trained around 4000 trainees, prepared additional 6 sector-specific training centers, and added 14 new machinery and software at the Design Facility Center under LFMEAB-SEIP phase-03.
- 18) Attended the 39th International Footwear Conference on 14th November, 2023
- 19) Advanced collaboration with FDDI, India.





Activities of LFMEAB Round the Year

Compliance Department

Objectives of Compliance Department

Objective of the Compliance department is to ensure that member factories operate ethically, responsibly, and in compliance with labor laws, human rights, and environmental standards. This includes monitoring and enforcing fair labor practices, decent work, ethical sourcing, environmental sustainability, and promoting a workplace culture that respects human rights and diversity. The department aims to uphold a comprehensive code of conduct, engage with stakeholders, conduct audits, and continually improve social responsibility practices.

Activities and outcomes of Compliance Department

The association has taken necessary steps to address the needs and concerns of member factories in particular and for the sector in general. The association has worked to serve members better. Major activities and outcomes are highlighted below:

- Conducted 212 audits in 125 different factories.
- Conducted **16** new membership appraisal assessments and provided provisional membership.
- Conducted Training of the Trainers (ToT) on Occupational Health and Safety and Chemical Management Systems where 40 participants attended from different factories.
- 100% Group insurance coverage for eligible factories.
- Delivered day long training on "Strengthening the Capacity of Factory Committees" at the industry level.
- Consultation with factory management for strengthening the different committee (Participation committee, Safety committee and Anti harrasement committee).
- Conducted an Electrical Fire Risk Assessment in the factory workplace to identify the hazards and guide the factory to mitigate.
- Approximately 95% of factories already covered the employment conditions, such as appointment letter, confirmation letter, ID card, and service book, as required by law.
- Conducted training on "Quality Awarness and Understanding" at the industry level where 150 participants attended.
- Developed Supply Chain Map (SCM) for the stakeholders.

Audit Status

From July 2022 – June 2023, the compliance team conducted 212 audits in 125 different factories, where 29% of factories obtained grade A, 16% of

factories obtained grade B, 16% of factories obtained grade C and 39% of factories obtained grade D as illustrated below:






Figure: Audit status at a glance from July'22- June'23





Factory Improvement Program (FIP)

With technical support from GIZ Bangladesh, a factory improvement program has been launched to develop social compliance among the footwear and leathergoods factories under the umbrella of LFMEAB. This program will continue till May 2024.


Key activities:

Social Dialogue Program-STILE

Under this program, LFMEAB has worked to build the capacity of the factory committees through social dialogue. The objective of this program is to create committee members effective roles within the factory. This program is supported by development partner – GIZ Bangladesh.

- 25 factories were trained on capacity building of the Participatory Committee, Safety Committee, and Anti-Harassment Committee.

- A competition will be held among these 25 factories to take additional measures for the improvement of the factories and employees.
- Best factory will be awarded for the best additional measures executed.

LFMEAB compliance department gives follow-up to the factories round the year for continued improvement of the factories.




Figure-01: Overall status of LFMEAB-SEIP Program in FY'2022-23



REPORT ON THE AUDIT OF THE FINANCIAL STATEMENTS

Opinion

REPORT ON THE AUDIT OF THE FINANCIAL STATEMENTS

Opinion

We have audited the financial statements of Leathergoods and Footwear Manufacturers & Exporters Association of Bangladesh (the Association), which comprise the statement of financial position as at 30 June 2023, and the statement of comprehensive income & expenditure and statement of receipts & payments for the year then ended, and notes to the financial statements, including a summary of significant accounting policies.

Leathergoods and Footwear Manufacturers & Exporters Association of Bangladesh Notes to the Financial Statement For the year ended 30 June 2023

1.00 About the Association:

Leathergoods and Footwear Manufacturers & Exporters Association of Bangladesh (LFMEAB) was established in 2003 as a company limited by guarantee and registered under section 28 of the Companies Act, 1994.

The Leathergoods and Footwear Manufacturers & Exporters Association of Bangladesh (LFMEAB) is the recognized trade body that represents most of the major export-oriented manufacturers & exporters of leather goods & footwear in Bangladesh. The association encourages Bangladesh's leather goods and footwear sector to grow into one that is integrated, globally competitive, and sustainable.

2.00 Objectives of the Association:

The fundamental objective of LFMEAB is to establish a healthy business environment for a close and mutually beneficial relationship between the local manufacturers & exporters of leather footwear & leather goods and foreign buyers. By teaching fundamental values such as a completely compliant workplace into all of our members, LFMEAB hope to establish the leather industry in Bangladesh as a significant investment choice for the rest of the world.

3.00 Summary of Significant Accounting Policies:

3.01 Basis of Accounting:

These financial statements have been prepared under historical cost convention on accrual basis in conformity with International Financial Reporting Standards (IFRS) except for:

- the Association prepares Statement of Receipts & Payments following cash basis instead of preparing Statement of Cash Flows; and
- the Association recognizes revenue following cash basis as mentioned in note # 3.03

3.02 Property, Plant and Equipment:

- a) The cost of an item of Property, Plant and Equipment is recognized as an asset if, it is probable that the future economic benefits associated with the item will flow to the organization and the cost of item can be measured reliably. Property, Plant and Equipment are stated at cost less accumulated depreciation. Cost represents the cost of acquisition which includes purchase price and other directly attributable cost of bringing the assets to working conditions for its intended use.
- b) Depreciation is charged on property, plant and equipment using reducing balance method. Depreciation is charged in the following rates:

3.03 Lease:

IFRS 16 replaces leases guidance, including IAS 17 Leases, IFRIC 4 Determining whether an Arrangement contains a Lease, SIC-15 Operating Leases – Incentives and SIC-27 Evaluating the Substance of Transactions Involving the Legal Form of a Lease.

The standard is effective for annual years beginning on or after 1 January 2019. Early adoption is permitted for entities that apply IFRS 15 at or before the date of initial application of IFRS 16.

IFRS 16 introduces a single, on-balance sheet lease accounting model for lessees. A lessee recognizes a right-of-use asset representing its right to use the underlying asset and a lease liability representing its obligation to make lease payments. There are recognition exemptions for short-term leases and leases of low-value items. Lessor accounting remains similar to the current standard – i.e. lessors continue to classify leases as finance or operating leases.

During the FY 2022-23, there are two (02) rental agreements which is applicable as leases under IFRS 16. However, the Association will recognize ROU assets and Lease liabilities in accordance with IFRS 16 from the FY 2023-24 following an approval by the Board of Directors.

3.04 Revenue Recognition:

LFMEAB earns revenue by (i) giving membership to the new members; (ii) by conducting the compliance audit to the existing and new members; (iii) by giving renewal to the existing members (iv) by giving certificates to the members as required; and (v) by giving training to the members about how to comply with the conditions to stay as members in the association. LFMEAB recognizes revenue following cash basis of accounting.

Types of Services:

a) Generalized System of Preference (GSP)

Buyers from the relevant nations benefit from preferential treatment while importing from Bangladesh. If our exporters can present the GSP certificate, buyers can get the items duty free from their port. As a result, members receive the EPB certificate. The EPB certificate is supported by LFMEAB. EPB issues certificates to LFMEAB member manufacturers based on this.

b) Export Certificate

LFMEAB is required to certify and propose the exports of its members. Following this certification, the lien bank will inspect exporters' files and transmit them to Bangladesh Bank. Bangladesh Bank approves their application and provides monetary incentives to exporters. LFMEAB certifies exports by examining supporting export paperwork from various stakeholders such as Customs, banks, and buyers.

c) Telegraphic Transfer Certificate (TT)

This is one kind of an Export Certificate. If any member exports on the basis of advance payment by buyers, LFMEAB will recommend to the bank that they receive cash incentive. The TT is issued by LFMEAB after evaluating relevant export documents from Customs, banks, and buyers.

d) Free of Cost Certificate (FOC)

This is the income from recommendation letter issued by the LFMEAB based on the SRO and Import Policy published by the Government. As per Import policy LFMEAB members can bring 500 pair shoes duty free as sample for developing design as per requirement of the buyers. NBR and Customs asks for the recommendation letter from association as a guarantor of the member companies.

e) No Objection Certificate (NOC)

NOC has is issued on case to case basis on different service issues. The association plays the role of a guarantor body for the exporters. NOC is issued by evaluating relevant documents of the said issue as per the checklist.





f) Recommendation Letter

Recommendation letter is issued by the Association to recommend member factories for different issues. Details are given below:

- i) Visa Recommendation: Members has to visit different countries for business issues. Association provides recommendation letter to the concerned embassy to approve their visa application. Also many buyers come to Bangladesh to do business with the members. Association also recommends concerned Dept. of Bangladesh to allow them visa to visit Bangladesh.
- **ii)** Bond License Auto Renewal: The association recommends bond license auto renewal to the bond office based on member factories' applications and supporting documentation.
- **iii) New HS Code Inclusion:** Members applied for the inclusion of the HS code in the import entitlement sheet to import new raw materials. The association provides a recommendation to the bond office based on the application of member factories and supporting documents.
- **iv) HS Code Amendment:** Members apply for amendment of HS code as per need of customs. The Association provides recommendation to the bond office based on the application of member factories and supporting documents.
- v) New Bond License: New member factories apply for their bond license to the bond office. To get this license members need association recommendation letters. Association provide recommendations to the bond office based on the application of member factories and supporting documents.
- **vi) Bonded warehouse extension:** Members apply for extension of the structure of Bonded warehouse to the bond office. To get this permission Association provides recommendations to the bond office based on the application of member factories and supporting documents.
- **vii) Factory Extension:** Members apply for an extension of the structure of the factory to the bond office. To get this permission Association provides recommendations to the bond office based on the application of member factories and supporting documents.
- **viii) Machinery Inclusion:** Members apply for the inclusion of new machinery at the factory to the bond office. To get this permission Association provides recommendations to the bond office based on the application of member factories and supporting documents.
- **ix) Bond Audit Recommendation:** After completion of the license period members need to face a bond audit. To complete the procedure they need to apply for conducting an audit at the Customs bond commission rate. The association provides recommendation letter on this issue based on their application and supporting documents.
- **x) Fire Safety Equipment duty exemption Recommendation:** Members apply for the Fire Safety Equipment duty exemption to the bond office. To get this permission Association provide recommendation to the bond office based on the application of member factories and supporting documents.

3.05 Cash and Cash Equivalents:

Cash and Cash Equivalents comprises of cash and bank balance.

3.06 Provision for Liabilities:

Provision and accrued expenses are recognized in the financial statements when the organization has a present obligation resulting from past events and it is probable that an outflow of resources embodying economic benefits will be required to settle the obligation, and a reliable estimate of the amount can be made.

3.07 Foreign Currency Transactions:

LFMEAB maintains its books of account in Bangladeshi Taka. Transactions in foreign currencies are accounted for in Bangladeshi Taka at the rate of exchange ruling on the date of transactions. There were no foreign currency transactions this year.





3.08 General Fund:

Leathergoods and Footwear Manufacturers & Exporters Association of Bangladesh is registered with the office of the Registrar of the Joint Stock Companies and Firms, Government of the People's Republic of Bangladesh under Section 28 of the Companies Act 1994 as a company limited by guarantee and without capital. The general fund represents excess of income over expenditures.

3.09 Tax:

Current tax is the expected tax payable or receivable on the taxable income or loss for the year, using tax rates enacted or substantively enacted at the reporting date, and any adjustment to tax payable in respect of previous years. Provision for corporate income tax is made following the rate applicable for companies as per Finance Act, 2023.

3.10 Reporting Period:

The financial statements cover one year from 01 July to 30 June which is followed consistently. These financial statements cover one year from 01 July 2022 to 30 June 2023.

Few of comparetive figures has been rearragned in current year i.e. Service charge & parking fees in Statement of Expenditures, Salary & allowance & Provident Fund - Employee's Contribution in Statement of Receipts and Payments and Advance, deposit and prepayments of Statement of Financial Position.

3.11 VAT Registration:

The Association is required to obtain VAT registration as per VAT Act, 2012. However, the Association will apply for VAT registration as soon as possible after the approval of the board of directors.

3.12 Submission under 75(A), 108 and 108 (A):

During the year, The Association did not submit "Information regarding payment of salary" under section 108, "Information regarding filing of return by employees" under section 108A and "Return of Withholding Tax" under section 75A to the Deputy Commissioner of Taxes of the concerned Tax Circle as per Income Tax Ordinance, 1984. However, the Association will submit the similar returns from the FY 2023-24 as per Income Tax Act, 2023.

3.13 Submission of RJSC Annual Return:

The Association has submitted the annual return till FY 2019-20. Online submission was initiated for latest years but those are still incomplete. The pending submission will be processed as early as possible.

3.14 Authorization for Issue

These Financial Statements have been authorized for issue by the Board of Directors on 10 January, 2024
