

Minutes of the 20th Annual General Meeting (AGM) of Leathergoods And Footwear Manufacturers & Exporters Association of Bangladesh (LFMEAB) held on Saturday, 09 March 2024.

The 20th Annual General Meeting (AGM) of Leathergoods And Footwear Manufacturers & Exporters Association of Bangladesh (LFMEAB) was held on Saturday, 09 March, 2024 at 6:30 pm at MCCI-BEF's Office, M. Anis Ud-Dowla Conference Hall, Police Plaza Concord, Tower -2, Level -6, Road-144, Gulshan-1, Dhaka. Mr. Mohammed Nazmul Hassan, Senior Vice President of LFMEAB presided over the AGM session.

Leave of Absence

President, Mr. Syed Nasim Manzur, conveyed his apologies for his absence to the board due to sickness. Board declared his leave of absence for the duration of the meeting. A motion was proposed and seconded to designate the Senior Vice President, Mr. Mohammed Nazmul Hassan, to preside over the meeting in the absence of the President. The motion was put to a vote and unanimously approved. Also, Vice President: Mr. Ziaur Rahman; Directors: Mr. Abdul Momen Bhuiyan, Mr. Hasnat Md. Abu Obida, and Mr. James Ho were granted leave of absence by the Board.

After the quorum of the meeting, Mr. Senior Vice President called the meeting to order. With permission from the Chair, Secretary General of LFMEAB Major Md Rafiqul Islam (Retd) read out the Notice of 20th Annual General Meeting for the year July 2022-June 2023, which was circulated earlier. Afterward, Mr. Senior Vice President welcomed all the members present at the AGM and proceeded with the meeting according to the following agenda:

1. To confirm the minutes of the 19th Annual General Meeting held on 08 January, 2023.
2. Presentation of the Annual Report FY 2022-2023 of the association and adoption thereof.
3. Presentation of the audited accounts of the association for the FY July, 2022-June, 2023 and auditor's report thereon.
4. To appoint auditor for FY July, 2023-June, 2024 and determine their remuneration.

Agenda-1: to confirm the minutes of the 19th Annual General Meeting held on 08 January, 2023.

The minutes of the 19th Annual General Meeting held on 08 January, 2023 at Hotel Lake Shore, House No-46, Road-41, Gulshan-2, Dhaka-1212, were circulated among the General Body members and placed before the AGM for approval. Mr. Senior Vice President invited comments from members on the tabled minutes. Mr. Senior Vice President proposed that if there was no objection, the minutes might be treated as read and confirmed. Having received no revisions or observations from anyone, on a proposal

from Mr. Mohd. Abdul Mannan, Chairman, Italy Footwear Limited. and seconded by Mr. Ibnul Wara, Managing Director, Austan Ltd., the meeting confirmed the minutes.

Agenda-2: Presentation of the Annual Report FY 2022-2023 of the association and adoption thereof.

Senior Vice President Mr. Hassan presented the Annual Report for the fiscal year July 2022-June 2023 where he highlighted the national outlook for the industry, major initiatives implemented, and a summary of the financial position. He reported that the export earnings from the country's leather sector, the second-largest earner of foreign currency after the ready-made garments (RMG) industry, reached 1702 USDM in FY 2022-2023. Mr. Hassan commented that the world economic growth slowed from 3.5 percent in 2022 to 3 percent in 2023 and forecast 2.9% in 2024. This bleak economic situation coupled with inflation in almost all markets has caused demand to fall inventory build-up in our major markets. Exporters are also facing cost pressures due to rising bank interest rates, increased power costs, minimum wage increases, and escalating freight costs. During the presentation, Mr. Senior Vice President also welcomed new 16 members of the Association.

After discussion, on the proposal from Mr. Jashim Md Al Amin, Managing Director of Zeil Wears Ltd. and seconded by Brigadier General Md Mamnur Rashid, Director of Bangladesh Machine Tools Factory Ltd. the meeting confirmed the presentation of the Annual Report 2022-2023.

Agenda-3: Presentation of the audited accounts of the association for the FY July, 2022-June, 2023 and auditor's report thereon.

Mr. Senior Vice President presented the audited accounts of the association for the year July 01, 2022 to June 30, 2023. There was item-wise discussion on the balance sheet, income-expenditure statement, etc. Mr. Senior Vice President asked if there was any comment that needed explanation. Members present expressed satisfaction with the financial position of the association. Mr. Senior Vice President then requested for acceptance and adoption of the Audited Accounts. The Audit Report of LFMEAB for the fiscal year July 2022-June 2023 was approved unanimously at the AGM on a proposal from Mr. Hedayetullah Ron, Managing Director, Footbed Footwear Limited. which was seconded by Ms. Amrita Makin Islam, Deputy Managing Director, Picard Bangladesh Limited.

Agenda-4: To appoint auditor for FY 2023- 2024 and determine their remuneration.

Mr. Senior Vice President informed the house that *ACNABIN Chartered Accountants* audit firm audited the accounts of the association from July 01, 2022 to June 30, 2023. He also informed that ACNABIN Chartered Accountants have expressed its desire to undertake the audit of the association in the FY July 2023 to June 2024 with the same amount of remuneration; Tk. 50,000/ (fifty thousand) only.

Ltd. and seconded by Mr. Md Hasanuzzaman, Chairman of Bling Leather Products Ltd.

Mr. Senior Vice President thanked the members present for attending the meeting which was made successful with their active participation. ANNUAL REPORT

(FY July 2023-June 2024)

Distinguished Members of the General Body and my dear colleagues in the Board of Directors, ladies, and gentlemen,
Assalamu Alaikum and good evening.

It is a great pleasure and opportunity for me to welcome you all in the 21st Annual General Meeting (AGM) of the fiscal year 2023-2024 of Leather-goods And Footwear Manufacturers & Exporters Association of Bangladesh (LFMEAB).

In the present context, I would like to apprise you the following issues –

- a) Current global economic outlook
- b) National economic situation
- c) Sectoral export performance
- d) Major activities of the association round the year, and
- e) Financial summary.

Current Global Economic Outlook

UNCTAD's Trade and Development Report 2024 illustrates that world economic growth slowed from 3.1% in 2022 to 2.7% in 2023, expecting the world economy to maintain the same subdued growth rate of 2.7% in 2024 and 2025, marking three years of stable but stagnating growth. On the other hand, according to IMF, world economic growth slightly slowed from 3.5% in 2022 to 3.3% in 2023 and growth is projected to hold steady at 3.2% in 2024 and 2025. M

In 2023, global demand for goods faced challenges, with a 5% decline in goods trade, due to multiple factors, including global inflation, higher energy prices, geopolitical tensions, and adjustments in supply chains due to “friend-shoring,” which prioritizes trade between geopolitically aligned nations. However, Consumer goods and retail outlook 2024

by Economist Intelligence Unit (EIU) predicts that globally retail volumes will expand by 6.7% in US dollar terms and 2% in volume terms in 2024 due to a slowdown in inflation.

UNCTAD's Trade and Development Report 2024 also reported that major international markets rebounded, including in the trade of manufactured products, services, primary commodities and financial assets and international trade in goods and services is expected to rebound by 2% to 3% in 2024. The rebound is mainly driven by a revival of merchandise trade that accounts for 75% of global commerce in value. Trade in services, on the other hand, is projected to expand faster, at around 5% in 2024.

Trends of the global trade turned positive in the first quarter of 2024, with the value of trade in goods increasing by around 1% quarter-over-quarter and services by about 1.5%. Global trade growth in the first quarter of 2024 was primarily driven by increased exports from China (9%), India (7%) and the USA (3%).

In contrast, S&P Global finds a marked decline in global export orders in 2024 due to several converging economic challenges, including weak demand, inflation, and high-interest rates that have diminished consumer spending across major economies. The broader manufacturing sector globally has responded to weak export orders by scaling back production. S&P Global reported that September 2024 marked one of the steepest declines in new export orders in recent years, with an annualized contraction of 3-4% in trade volumes.

Major economies have experienced a downturn in merchandise trade in 2023. The performance of the top 10 economies in the world in terms of merchandise trade in 2023 is mixed. While China, Germany, Brazil and Italy maintained a positive trade balance,


the remaining six countries, namely, the United States, Japan, India, the United Kingdom, France and Canada experienced a negative trade balance. However, the first quarter (Q1) of 2024 shows an upturn in merchandise trade, but only for some. Specifically, imports increased for Brazil, the Russian Federation, and the United States. On the export side, China and India exhibited very strong quarter-over-quarter export performance. Exports also grew for the Russian Federation and the United States. From this aforementioned discussion, it is assumed that slow market demand, sluggish manufacturing and export business at home and abroad could paint a bleak economic scenario in the year ahead.

The global Leather Goods market increased by 5.4% to USD 261.5 billion in 2023, compared to USD 248.1 billion in 2022, according to Global Market Insights. On the other hand, World Footwear Yearbook 2024 reported that global footwear production in 2023 reached 22.4 billion pairs, a 6% decrease over the previous year. The top 10 footwear exporting countries including China, Vietnam and Indonesia all experienced a decline in export volumes in 2023 compared to the previous year. Following this trend, despite the gradually easing of supply chain and commodity price pressures, demand for apparel and footwear will remain weak in 2024 according to Standard & Poor's Consumer Goods 2024 Outlook. This is because consumer spending focuses on staples, services, and travel instead of discretionary apparel and footwear.

National Economic Situation

Bangladesh's economy has demonstrated remarkable resilience and robust growth in the post-pandemic era, with real GDP expanding by 6.94% in FY2020-21 and 7.10% in FY2021-22, but growth moderated to 5.78% in FY2022-23 and increased slightly to 5.82% in FY2023-24 as per provisional estimates from the Bangladesh Bureau of Statistics against the target of 7.5%. However, according to the World Bank, Bangladesh's GDP grew by 5.2% in FY 2023-24 down from 5.78% in FY 2022-23. Persistent high inflation, substantial depreciation of BDT, and challenges stemming from the Russia-Ukraine conflict, the

conflict in the Middle East, global uncertainty, and adverse conditions such as slower-than-expected growth and rising inflation in key trade partners and remittance sources have led to sluggish GDP growth.





Bangladesh recorded its lowest economic growth in the past five quarters in the last quarter of Fiscal Year 2023-24 due to contractionary monetary and fiscal policies to tackle the dwindling forex reserves and high inflation. Between April and June this year, the GDP grew by 3.91%, compared to 6.88% in SPLY.

According to the Export Promotion Bureau (EPB), Bangladesh earned \$44.47 billion in export earnings in fiscal year 2023-24, seeing a negative growth of 4.27% year-on-year. Furthermore, comparing export earnings with the export target showed a negative growth of 28.27%, which was set at \$62 billion. At the end of June 2024, export earnings dropped by 5.89% and imports by 10.61%. Raw material imports declined by 15.9% in FY2023-24, while capital machinery import fell 23.86%, according to BB's letters of credit settlement statistics. Thus, rising input costs, slow demand, supply chain disruptions stemming from ongoing economic turmoil and geopolitical crisis, and inflationary pressures in key destinations may be termed as the main reasons of this lackluster export performance. Consequently, exporters are going through a tight business situation due to, among others, disruptions in logistic networks and increased shipping costs, inadequate energy supply, high inflation, and rising prices of raw materials.

Sectoral Export Performance

Export earnings from the country's leather, leather products, and footwear sector witnessed 7% decrease in the FY2023-24, compared to a growth of 0.48% in the FY2022-23.

In FY 2023-24:

- ✓ Total sectoral export, comprising leather & leather products (41-43 & 6403) and non-leather footwear (64 Excluding 6403), declined to USD 1456 million from USD 1560 million in FY 2022-23.
- ✓ Leather & leather products (41-43 & 6403) export was USD 1039 million.
- ✓ Export of leather products (42-43) was USD 353 million, 2% decrease over SPLY.
- ✓ Export of leather footwear (6403) was USD 544 million, 22% decrease over SPLY.
- ✓ Export of non-leather footwear (64 without 6403) was USD 417 million, 8% increase over SPLY.

Overall, export performance in the reported period shows that leather products and leather footwear experienced downward trend while leather and non-leather footwear surpassed the export performance of the previous fiscal year with a slight upward trend.

Key Achievement and Activities of LFMEAB

In addition to providing timely services to the members, LFMEAB serves as a platform for communication, and coordination with concerned ministries, national and international organizations, development partners, and related stakeholders to provide policy support to its members in particular and for export promotion in general. After the last AGM, LFMEAB had worked with many policy issues and completed many events and activities for the sector interest. Following are the most notable events of the financial year 2023-2024:

- ✓ A gazette was published by NBR for footwear and leathers goods to decrease source tax from 1% to 0.5% till 30th June, 2025.
- ✓ With the follow-up from LFMEAB Board, NBR has published an SRO to increase the validity of Bond License from 2 years to 3 years
- ✓ Association took initiative with Ministry of Commerce and Ministry of Foreign Affairs to extend the date of imposition of BIS. With that it was extended for six months.
- ✓ Leathers goods and footwear sector has been upgraded from Orange category to Yellow by the Department of Environment.
- ✓ More than 25 factories were trained on capacity building of the Participatory Committee, Safety Committee, and Anti-Harassment Committee under the Social Dialogue Program-STILE initiative. Picard Bangladesh Ltd. and Blue Ocean Footwear Ltd., achieved best practice award on social dialogue approach. Two of the officials of LFMEAB were awarded best trainers award under this program.
- ✓ LFMEAB took an initiative to digitalize of its services with the technical support of GIZ-Bangladesh. The project was launched at Radisson Blu Water Garden Hotel, Dhaka in presence of members, relevant stakeholders, development partners, diplomates and govt. officials.
- ✓ Issued 14297 different basic services such as Export certificates, TT certificates, GSP recommendations, and bond license recommendations etc.
- ✓ Conducted 232 compliance audits in 130 different factories.
- ✓ On 11 May, 2024, organized a workshop on “Costing and Negotiation Skills” at Amari, Dhaka in which about 150 participants attended from different member factories.
- ✓ Participated in many seminars, round-tables, dialogues, and consultations on different trade, export, and policy-related issues to highlight the leather products and footwear sector's challenges and presented our evidence-based points of view.
- ✓ Ensured 100% Group Insurance coverage for eligible 91 factories.
- ✓ Ascertained coefficients of 29 factories for 555 footwear and leather goods articles.
- ✓ With technical support of GIZ Bangladesh, LFMEAB has successfully completed Factory Improvement Program by assessing 100 factories on the basis of social and environment compliance.
- ✓ An MoU was signed between LFMEAB and Footwear Design and Development Institute (FDDI), India to share academic knowledge and skill development of the sector.
- ✓ 1st batch of students were sent to FDDI, Kolkata campus for “Advanced level design training on Footwear” under this MoU. Participants had successfully completed the training and achieved

competencies on biomechanics, pedagogy, human ergonomics and design etc.

- ✓ KRC of LFMEAB continued to provide sector-related data, research-backed policy briefs, position papers, and maintain collaboration with global industry stakeholders among others.
- ✓ During the FY 2023-24, LFMEAB- Skills for Employment Investment Program (SEIP) was concluded with the implementation of the Tranche-03 with a total enrollment of 4287 trainees, out of which 2634 were female. Also, a total of 2932 trainees received job placement, which is 77.44% of total certified trainees.
- ✓ Attended the 40th International Footwear Conference (IFC) of CIFA on 03-05 August, 2023 at Jakarta, Indonesia.
- ✓ Under the activity of LSBPC, 250 officials from 10 member factories have received 5 days training on productivity and lean management.
- ✓ 60 factory officials have received intensive training on “Leadership and Productivity” with the collaboration of LSBPC.
- ✓ LFMEAB receives 25 new members in the association.



ACNABIN Chartered Accountants audited the accounts of the Association for the period of July 01, 2023 to June 30, 2024. In the audit report, we have placed the income and expenditure and Balance Sheet for FY 2023-2024. The summary is reflected in the below infographic.



Based on the audited records, the association's total income for the period amounted to BDT 3,59,66,837/-, reflecting an increase from the previous year's income of BDT 2,88,02,935/-. Meanwhile, the total expenditure for the period was BDT 3,00,85,601/-, up from BDT 2,55,00,704/- in the previous year. Although the expenditure increased by BDT 45.85 lacs, the percentage of expenses relative to income decreased by 2%, positively contributing to the Income over expenditure figure.






- Ensured **100%** Group insurance coverage for 91 eligible factories.


Compliance Audit Status

During the FY2023-24, the Compliance team conducted 232 audits in 130 different member factories, where 34% of factories obtained grade A, 29% of factories obtained grade B, 19% of factories obtained grade C, 13% of factories obtained grade D and 04% of factories obtained grade E as illustrated below:


Grade Improvement Status: FY23 and FY24



- ✓ In FY2023-24, the compliance status of 2 factories have improved from E to D, 4 factories from D to C, 2 factories from D to B, 11 factories from C to B and 7 factories from B to A grade.
- ✓ There has been significant improvement in the upgradation of factories from C to B grade (267%) and from B to A (17%) between FY2023-24 and FY2022-23.
- ✓ In FY2023-24, 11 factories have improved from C to B, compared to only 3 in FY2022-23.
- ✓ In FY2023-24, 7 factories have improved from B to A, compared to 6 in FY2022-23.







Factory Improvement Program (FIP)



The Factory Improvement Program (FIP) is a collaboration between the GIZ Bangladesh & LFMEAB, which aims to contribute to improving the social standards of the workers and increase the competitiveness of the leather sector in Bangladesh. INDEPENDENT AUDITOR'S REPORT

To the Members of Leathergoods and Footwear Manufacturers & Exporters Association of Bangladesh

REPORT ON THE AUDIT OF THE FINANCIAL STATEMENTS

Opinion

We have audited the financial statements of Leathergoods and Footwear Manufacturers & Exporters Association of Bangladesh (the Association), which comprise the statement of financial position as at 30 June 2024, and the statement of comprehensive income & expenditure and statement of receipts & payments for the year then ended, and notes to the financial statements, including a summary of material accounting policies.

In our opinion, the accompanying financial statements present fairly, in all material respects, the financial position of the Association as at 30 June 2024, and its financial performance and its receipts & payments for the year then ended in accordance with International Financial Reporting Standards (IFRSs) and other applicable laws and regulations, as explained in **note # 3** to the financial statements.

Basis for Opinion

We conducted our audit in accordance with International Standards on Auditing (ISAs). Our responsibilities under those standards are further described in the Auditors' Responsibilities for the Audit of the Financial Statements section of our report. We are independent of the Association in accordance with the International Ethics Standards Board for Accountants' Code of Ethics for Professional Accountants (IESBA Code) together with the ethical requirements that are relevant to our audit of the financial statements in Bangladesh, and we have fulfilled our other ethical responsibilities in accordance with these ethical requirements. We believe that the audit evidence we have obtained is sufficient and appropriate to provide a basis for our opinion.

Emphasis of Matters

1. In note 3.10 to the financial statements, the Association disclosed the reason for their non-obligation for payment of Workers's Profit Participation Fund as per Section 232 of Labour Law, 2006.



2. In note 5 to the financial statements, the Association disclosed the reason for not recognizing BDT 19,225 held in the Nagad account of the Association as of 30 June 2024.
3. In note 11 to the financial statements, the Association disclosed BDT 36,942,476 as "General Fund" which inter alia includes BDT 2,884,973 as "Current Year Adjustment" related to transferring balance from "Welfare Fund" (note 13). However, this fund transfer was made without obtaining any board approval.
4. In note 18 to the financial statements, the Association disclosed BDT 13,365,006 as "Salary & Benefits". However, the Association did not follow in some cases section 86(1) of Income Tax Act, 2023 for deducting tax from employee's salary.

Our opinion is not modified in respect of the above matters.

Other Matters

1. The Association did not submit "Return of Withholding Tax" to the Deputy Commissioner of Taxes of as per section 177 of Income Tax Act, 2023.
2. The Association does not have a complete ERP solution but uses a Tally system for which no network diagram and audit trail logs were found and inadequate password security was observed. The management of the Association is working on the system to fix the issues with the system and develop a complete ERP solution.

Other Information

Management is responsible for the other information. The other information comprises the information included in the Board of Directors Report but does not include the financial statements and our auditor's report thereon.

Our opinion on the financial statements does not cover the other information and we do not express any form of assurance conclusion thereon since we have not been provided with any such information.

In connection with our audit of the financial statements, our responsibility is to read the other information and, in doing so, consider whether the other information is materially inconsistent with the financial statements or our knowledge obtained in the audit, or otherwise appears to be materially misstated. If, based on the work we have performed, we conclude that there is a material misstatement of this other information, we are required to report that fact. We have nothing to report in this regard. However, when we read the Directors Report, if we conclude that there is a material misstatement therein, we are required to communicate the matter to those charged with governance.



Responsibilities of Management and Those Charged with Governance for the Financial Statements

Management is responsible for the preparation and fair presentation of the financial statements in accordance with IFRSs and other applicable laws and regulations as explained in note # 3 to the financial statements, and for such internal control as management determines is necessary to enable the preparation of financial statements that are free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error.

In preparing the financial statements, management is responsible for assessing the its ability to continue as a going concern, disclosing, as applicable, matters related to going concern and using the going concern basis of accounting unless management either intends to liquidate the Association or to cease operations or has no realistic alternative but to do so.

Those charged with governance are responsible for overseeing the Association's financial reporting process.

Auditor's Responsibilities for the Audit of the Financial Statements

Our objectives are to obtain reasonable assurance about whether the financial statements as a whole are free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error, and to issue an auditor's report that includes our opinion. Reasonable assurance is a high level of assurance, but is not a guarantee that an audit conducted in accordance with ISAs will always detect a material misstatement when it exists. Misstatements can arise from fraud or error and are considered material if, individually or in the aggregate, they could reasonably be expected to influence the economic decisions of users taken on the basis of these financial statements.

As part of an audit in accordance with ISAs, we exercise professional judgement and maintain professional skepticism throughout the audit. We also:

- Identify and assess the risks of material misstatement of the financial statements, whether due to fraud or error, design and perform audit procedures responsive to those risks, and obtain audit evidence that is sufficient and appropriate to provide a basis for our opinion. The risk of not detecting a material misstatement resulting from fraud is higher than for one resulting from error, as fraud may involve collusion, forgery, intentional omissions, misrepresentations, or the override of internal control.
- Obtain an understanding of internal control relevant to the audit in order to design audit procedures that are appropriate in the circumstances.
- Evaluate the appropriateness of accounting policies used and the reasonableness of accounting estimates and related disclosures made by management.
- Conclude on the appropriateness of management's use of the going concern basis of accounting and, based on the audit evidence obtained, whether a material uncertainty exists related to events or conditions that may cast significant doubt on the association's ability to continue as a going concern. If we conclude that a material uncertainty exists, we are required to draw attention in our auditor's report to the related disclosures in the financial statements or, if such disclosures are inadequate, to modify our opinion. Our conclusions are based on



the audit evidence obtained up to the date of our auditor's report. However, future events or conditions may cause the Association to cease to continue as a going concern.

- Evaluate the overall presentation, structure, and content of the Association's financial statements, including the disclosures, and whether the financial statements represent the underlying transactions and events in a manner that achieves fair presentation.

REPORT ON OTHER LEGAL AND REGULATORY REQUIREMENTS

We also report that:

- We have obtained all the information and explanations which, to the best of our knowledge and belief, were necessary for the purpose of our audit and made due verification thereof;
- In our opinion, proper books of accounts as required by law have been kept by the Association so far as it appeared from our examination of those books; and
- The Association's statement of financial position and statement of profit or loss and other comprehensive income together with Notes 1 to 31 dealt with by the report are in agreement with the books of account.





Note to the Financial Statement
As at and for the year ended 30 June 2024

1.00 About the Association:

Leathergoods And Footwear Manufacturers & Exporters Association of Bangladesh (LFMEAB) was established in 2003 as a company limited by guarantee and registered under section 28 of the Companies Act, 1994.

The Leathergoods And Footwear Manufacturers & Exporters Association of Bangladesh (LFMEAB) is the recognized trade body that represents most of the major export-oriented manufacturers & exporters of leather goods & footwear in Bangladesh.

The Association encourages Bangladesh's leather goods and footwear sector to grow into one that is integrated, globally competitive, and sustainable.

2.00 Objectives of the Association:

The fundamental objective of LFMEAB is to establish a healthy business environment for a close and mutually beneficial relationship between the local manufacturers & exporters of leather footwear & leather goods and foreign buyers. By teaching fundamental values such as a completely compliant workplace into all of our members, LFMEAB expects to establish the leather industry in Bangladesh as a significant investment choice for the rest of the world.

3.00 Summary of Significant Accounting Policies

3.01 Basis of Accounting:

These financial statements have been prepared under historical cost convention on accrual basis in conformity with International Financial Reporting Standards (IFRS) except for the following:

- the Association prepares Statement of Receipts & Payments following cash basis instead of preparing Statement of Cash Flows; and
- the Association recognizes revenue following cash basis as mentioned in note # 3.03.

3.02 Property, Plant and Equipment:

a) The cost of an item of Property, Plant and Equipment is recognized as an asset if, it is probable that the future economic benefits associated with the item will flow to the organization and the cost of item can be measured reliably. Property, Plant and Equipment are stated at cost less accumulated depreciation. Cost represents the cost of acquisition includes purchase price and other directly attributable cost of bringing the assets to working conditions for its intended use.

b) Depreciation is charged on property, plant and equipment using reducing balance method. Depreciation is charged in the following rates:

3.03 **Revenue Recognition**

LFMEAB earns revenue by (i) giving membership to the new members; (ii) by conducting the compliance audit to the existing and new members; (iii) by giving renewal to the existing members (iv) by giving certificates to the members as required; and (v) by giving training to the members about how to comply with the conditions to stay as members in the Association. LFMEAB recognizes revenue following cash basis of accounting.

Training and Services:

a) Generalized System of Preference (GSP)

Buyers from the relevant nations benefit from preferential treatment while importing from Bangladesh. If our exporters can present the GSP certificate, buyers can get the items duty free from their port. As a result, members receive the EPB certificate. The EPB certificate is supported by LFMEAB. EPB issues certificates to LFMEAB member manufacturers based on this.

b) Export Certificate

LFMEAB recommends to the lien bank to certify the exports of its members by examining supporting export paperwork from various stakeholders, such as customs, banks, and buyers. Following this recommendation, the lien bank inspects exporters' files and transmits them to Bangladesh Bank after undertaking necessary formalities. Bangladesh Bank approves their application and remits monetary incentives to exporters.

c) Telegraphic Transfer Certificate (TT)

LFMEAB recommends to the bank for allowing cash incentives for their members who export on the basis of advance payment (Telegraphic Transfers) by the buyers after evaluating relevant export documents from Customs, Banks, Buyers.

d) Free Of Cost Certificate (FOC)

LFMEAB issues a recommendation letter to NBR and customs as a guarantor of the member companies so that they can bring 500 pairs of shoes duty-free as samples for developing designs as per the requirements of buyers. This recommendation letter is based on the SRO and Import policy Published by the Government.

e) No Objection Certificate (NOC)

LFMEAB issues NOC by evaluating relevant documents required by the Association for issuing different services as a guarantor body for the exporters.

f) Recommendation Letter

Recommendation letter is issued by the Association to recommend member factories for different issues. Details are given below:

i) Visa Recommendation: Members has to visit different countries for business issues. The Association provides recommendation letter to the concerned embassy to approve their visa application. Also many buyers come to Bangladesh to do business with the members. The Association also recommends to the concerned Dept. of Bangladesh to allow them visa to visit Bangladesh.

ii) Bond License Auto Renewal: The Association recommends bond license auto renewal to the Bond office based on member factories' applications and supporting documentation.



iii) New HS Code Inclusion : Members apply for the inclusion of HS code in the import entitlement sheet to import new raw materials. The Association provides a recommendations to the Bond office based on the application of member factories and supporting documents.

iv) HS Code Amendment: Members apply for amendment of HS code as per need of customs. The Association provides recommendations to the Bond office based on the application of member factories and supporting documents.

v) New Bond License: New member factories apply for their bond license to the Bond office. To get this license members need the Association's recommendation letters. The Association provides recommendations to the Bond office based on the applications of member factories and supporting documents.

vi) Bonded warehouse extension: Members apply for extension of the structure of Bonded warehouse to the Bond office. To get this permission the Association provides recommendations to the Bond office based on the applications of member factories and supporting documents.

vii) Factory Extension: Members apply for extension of the structure of factory to the Bond office. To get this permission the Association provides recommendations to the Bond office based on the applications of member factories and supporting documents.

viii) Machinery Inclusion: Members apply for the inclusion of new machineries at factory to the Bond office. To get this permission the Association provides recommendations to the Bond office based on the applications of member factories and supporting documents.

ix) Bond Audit Recommendations: After completion of licence period members need to face bond audit. To complete the procedure they need to apply for conducting audit at Customs Bond Commissionerate. The Association provides recommendations letter on this issue based on their applications and supporting documents.

x) Fire Safety Equipment duty exemption Recommendations: Members apply for the Fire Safety Equipment duty exemption to the Bond office. To get this permission the Association provides recommendations to the Bond office based on the applications of member factories and supporting documents.

3.04 Cash and Cash Equivalents:

Cash and Cash Equivalents comprise of cash and bank balance.

3.05 Provision for Liabilities:

Provision and accrued expenses are recognized in the financial statements when the organization has a present obligation resulting from past events and it is probable that an outflow of resources embodying economic benefits will be required to settle the obligation, and a reliable estimate of the amount can be made.

3.06 Foreign Currency Transactions:

LFMEAB maintains its books of account in Bangladeshi Taka. Transactions in foreign currencies are accounted for in Bangladeshi Taka at the rate of exchange ruling on the date of transactions. There were no foreign currency transactions this year.

3.07 Lease:

As per IFRS 16, a lessee recognizes a right-of-use asset representing its right to use the underlying asset and a lease liability representing its obligation to make lease payments. The Association's right-of-use assets and the current and non-current portion of lease liabilities are included as separate line items within the statement of financial position. There are recognition exemptions for short-term leases and leases of low-value items. Lessor accounting remains similar to the current standard – i.e. lessors continue to classify leases as finance or operating leases.



The Association applied the short-term lease recognition exemption to its short-term leases of facilities. Lease payments on short-term leases and leases of low value assets are recognized as expense in profit or loss on a straight-line basis over the lease term. The Association has two short term lease agreement for one year which has not been capitalized as per policy mentioned above.

3.08 General Fund:

Leathergoods and Footwear Manufacturers & Exporters Association of Bangladesh is registered with the office of the Registrar of the Joint Stock Companies and Firms, Government of the People's Republic of Bangladesh under Section 28 of the Companies Act 1994 as a company limited by guarantee and without capital. The general fund represents excess of income over expenditures.

3.09 Tax

Current tax is the expected tax payable or receivable on the taxable income or loss for the year, using tax rates enacted or substantively enacted at the reporting date, and any adjustment to tax payable in respect of previous years. Provision for corporate income tax is made following the rate applicable for companies as per Finance Act, 2024.

3.10 Workers' Profit Participation Fund

The Association is a non-profit organization and has no obligation for payment of the Workers' Profit Participation Fund (WPPF).

3.11 Reporting Period:

The financial statements cover one year from 01 July to 30 June which is followed consistently. These financial statements cover one year from 01 July 2023 to 30 June 2024.

3.12 Authorization for Issue

These Financial Statements have been authorized for issue by the Board of Directors on 18th December 2024.

3.13 General:

- i. The figures in the financial statements have been rounded off to the nearest Taka (BDT) whenever necessary.
- ii. Previous year figures have been re-arranged wherever considered necessary to conform to the current year's presentation.




